In addition to being an outstanding conductor, Eylar is also a composer of international renown and a highly respected educator professor of music at California State University, Sacramento.

The CYS Wind program offers three ensembles under the direction of Rosita Amador. Ms. Amador has a B.A. in music from San Jose State University and she performs regularly with such groups as the Santa Cruz Symphony and Opera San Jose.

The CYS Percussion Program is under the direction of Artie Storch. Mr. Storch has a master's degree from The Juilliard School and appears regularly with the San Francisco Symphony and other local orchestras. He is also the Percussion Director at California State University East Bay and Chabot College.
